#### DO WE REALLY GO TO HEAVEN?

WHEN WE DIE .....

In just about every non Adventist funeral I've been to; the preacher preaches the person that has expired into heaven.

Saying things like; "he or she is with Jesus now", and then they usually always add; "looking down on us so don't cry, because we will see them again someday, and just about always, in the next breath, they read the following text;

#### I Corinthians. 15: <sup>51</sup>Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, <sup>52</sup>In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. <sup>53</sup>For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. <sup>54</sup>So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory. <sup>55</sup>O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory? <sup>56</sup>The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law. <sup>57</sup>But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>58</sup>Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.

These men, so called preachers<sup>1</sup> have been deceived by the state of the art of religion today and it doesn't take a rocket scientist to determine it either, they are blinded, blind to the light.

All it takes is just reading this one text alone, and it's all clear, the truth in this matter, that proves "no one goes to heaven when they die", proving that these so called men of the word are not really men of the Word at all. But false shepherds following after false prophets, following after tradition, and unknowingly following after their father's father Satan, who, get this now; "was the first to come up with this same lie, the first one of this nature, saying; "surely you won't die". Isn't that what he said to Eve? But then they did, and friend check it out, so do all even Jesus, so what then happens to them, save Jesus and a few exceptions, I ask then; "what happens to all of them including you and me Adam and Eve, David, Paul who of all have been found worthy of Grace, "if they don't go to heaven then what happens to them?"

#### We just read it, Paul said it!

It's plain as the nose on your face, and it can't be misinterpreted, unless viewed with blinded eyes!

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Some of these men have the audacity to even call themselves "reverend" a title only Jesus could be given, and some even defy Jesus (<u>Matthew 23:9</u>) calling themselves "fathers", and one even defies heaven by calling himself a "Christ", beware of such, run away from such, they have been self deceived or deceived by others (<u>II Timothy 3:13</u>, <u>I Timothy 2:14</u>) that being, being their real father "Satan". I know it's hard to hear much less to believe that, but wait till you see all the Truth on these two subjects first before you decide to put this study down, it just might be the difference in being deceived by God Himself because He has made His "truth" on these subjects very clear and it is the rejection of the Truth that matters to Him. (<u>II Thessalonians 2:10-12</u>)

But before we read the answer again to our question of "what really happens to a person when they die", let me ask you another question first, and I want you to think hard about it, because it will determine whether you are going to follow God or not in this matter, or whether you are going to follow the lie perpetuated by Satan "in paradise mind you", and clear up to today, and then you perpetuate it yourself.

What purpose would the resurrection of the dead, Paul just spoke of, being the righteous dead as he was addressing, I ask; "What purpose would a resurrection of the righteous serve, if everyone saved is already in heaven?"

"What is Jesus even coming back for in other words?"

"Who is Jesus coming back for?"

Didn't He say in that well memorized text; John 14:1-3 "Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me"....[remember what He added?].... 'I'm going to my Father's house to prepare for you a place.. and I'm coming back to get you and take you there?' I'm paraphrasing but this is obviously what He meant, "I'm coming back" is the key phrase, from where does He come back from?

Doesn't the Bible teach that he's coming back again to get us?

Didn't Paul mention that in our first text, and didn't he also mention something about us all being "asleep" too "when He comes"?

Notice what Paul says in another text on this same subject of life after death, and notice how he starts out with the subject of the coming of Jesus as it relates to this "sleep question" and possibly our ignorance on this subject because of deceptions, traditions and false teachings, or frankly just a lack of knowing Gods Word on this subject, knowing the Truth from "Gods Word alone" not some man no matter their credentials;

Notice how He starts this next text out;

I Thessalonians. 4: <sup>13</sup>But I would not have <u>you to be ignorant</u>, brethren, concerning them which are asleep.....

Ignorant about what?

Them which are <u>asleep</u>, the same ones from the previous text and exactly what we are talking about here, the dead!

<sup>15</sup>For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.

Do you see he is contrasting between the dead as opposed to those who are alive; the dead [those asleep] who obviously according to Paul are still dead, get this; "at the second coming" when all this is going to happen, the last trump, resurrection and all, but remember, and he is writing to us all not just the people of his day or you could throw out all the testament writings as no counsel for us anytime,

but, notice the most important point in this text for us to take heed; he started out first by saying; "I don't want you to be ignorant of these coming events".

<sup>16</sup>For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

(There it is those who are asleep "are the righteous in and thru Christ" but they are the dead in context here)

<sup>17</sup>Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.
 <sup>18</sup>Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

When do the dead then, who are still dead at this point, dead and buried, and of course the righteous dead to even get raised, I ask; "when do they finally arise from the dead?" Paul is perfectly clear here: "At the last trump from our last text" which we are going back to read again, but, it's those who remain righteous including those which are alive (Paul hoping to be one of those by his expression) that are caught up to meet Jesus", we who 'are alive' at the second coming in that context, but only after the "last trumpet sounds" which wakes up the dead who had been dead or "asleep" till then, but it's not till then by the trumpet and grace of God they are raised, to go to heaven where Jesus had prepared for them a place "to be with Him forever".

This is so clear, and it leaves no ground for people believing that they are going to heaven right after die, but they will remain in their grave "asleep" until the second coming, and listen; it's not "till the second coming that they will receive their reward" [of immortality] that reward "Jesus brings with Him", it's true!

Not until the second coming will they get their reward or Jesus lied to us, and we know that's not possible, nor did He (Jesus) miss speak to John, nor did John misunderstand Him either, it's clear in His (Jesus') last promise to us from the last book of the Bible;

Rev. 22:

<sup>10</sup>And he saith unto me, Seal not the sayings of the prophecy of this book: for the time is at hand.
<sup>11</sup>He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: and he which is filthy, let him be filthy still: and he that is righteous, let him be righteous still: and he that is holy, let him be holy still.
<sup>12</sup>And, behold, I come quickly; and <u>my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.</u>

How clear is that?

Notice in this context, about the second coming, we are seeing a predicted future event and not "a secrete" one either, much less silent!

When this great edict goes forth from heaven pronouncing the end of time; when obviously the judgment has been set and every case for the righteous has heard, and the "INDIVIDUAL" (not corporate! BIG point) rewards have been assigned based on where the living stand at the time of this edict, and obviously where the dead stood at the time of their death, either righteous or unrighteous,

and <u>Jesus</u> says; "I'm coming and bringing my reward with me" (meaning they haven't been given yet) to give every man what? "According as his work shall be", either they were righteous or unrighteous in the end as the judgment has recorded and has charged.

So the Judgment has just taken place right before that second coming, and the reward of eternal life, which is "immortality", is just then given out! Therefore, no one could have already received it until then! (Immortality that is! What it takes to live after death) what Paul says he will receive then as we are going to read from scripture as well, that is; unless God gave them their reward earlier like Enoch, Elijah, Elisha, Moses, including Jesus who "<u>did</u> go to heaven", but, and get this now, the only way they could have gone there and lived all this time "is for them to have already received their reward" based on what? "Their works of course"

God is not partial or divided in His judgments, and that's immortality if they are still alive in heaven after all these years as we know they are, that's the reward of "life forever" as promised in Eden.

For us who have not been given immortality and remain, as Paul, we will remain mortals in the death of sleep "until the resurrection", until "the last trump sounds", and then we along with the living righteous will then cease to be mortals, and receive, with Paul, our reward of immortality; "at the second coming and those who sleep in the graves come up from the dead <u>not down from heaven</u>" (that doesn't even make sense), and those resurrected with those who are alive "then" at that second coming day, all who were of the righteous from forever, then they, and we, will then be caught up to meet Jesus in the sky, and then "at that moment in time", then we will be given immortality, and then we will live forever as immortal's but not until then! "Glory be to God who gives us this, even though we don't deserve it, may I add", and any other explanation is not Biblical therefore a lie perpetuated by the unrighteous claiming to be.

Let's go back now to our first text and read it with wisdom now, as it is no longer a mystery, and now when we can read it we cannot not remain ignorant as are 99% of the preachers (or so called) out there have chosen to be, willfully ignorant or worse "have been disillusioned by God<sup>2</sup>, [I call them false shepherds as did Jesus (re <u>Mathew 24</u>)].

Now I'm going to show you "the clincher", the unequivocal truth of this matter, so that you will not listen to those deceivers any longer who perpetuate doctrines of devils to pull you in, but so that you will search for the fold of the remnant church (defined in <u>Rev. 12:17, 14:12, 14</u>) where they are described as having a unique faith one in Biblical Truths "so defined by the Bible only" and not some church or religion of the 1000's here in the end of time just before that edict is given and the Savior coming with His rewards in the clouds.

I Corinthians. 15:

 <sup>51</sup>Behold, I shew you a mystery; <u>We shall not all sleep</u>, but <u>we shall all be changed</u>,
 <sup>52</sup>In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, <u>at the last trump</u>: for the trumpet shall sound, and <u>the dead shall be</u> <u>raised</u> incorruptible, and we shall be changed.
 <sup>53</sup>For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this <u>mortal must put on immortality</u>.

 <sup>56</sup>The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law<sup>3</sup>.
 <sup>57</sup>But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
 <sup>58</sup>Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord,

forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.

Now you read what I underlined and yet did you miss the absolute proof "that this false doctrine started by the (mother) church early on in this last generation, and she has spread her lies (actually Satan's remember) she has spread her lies into about every Protestant (Daughter) church (i.e. Rev. 18), and even into your soul to make you ignorant of the Truths of Jesus, possibly causing you to miss the punch line of the Truth on this subject.

Let's read Paul's words on this subject again, taken as we are to take scripture (Isaiah 28:9-10, 13), and I'll underline them again for emphasis, and we will bring this study to an end;

I Thessalonians. 4: <sup>13</sup>But <u>I would not have you to be ignorant</u>, brethren, <u>concerning them which are asleep</u>.....

I Corinthians. 15:

<sup>51</sup>Behold, <u>I shew you a mystery</u>; <u>We shall not all sleep</u>, but we shall all be changed,
 <sup>52</sup>In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.
 <sup>53</sup>For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and <u>this mortal must put on immortality</u>.
 <sup>54</sup>So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, <u>then shall</u> <u>be brought to pass</u> the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.
 <sup>55</sup>O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?
 <sup>56</sup>The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law.
 <sup>57</sup>But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
 <sup>58</sup>Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.

In summary; "just then" at the "last trump" shall we who have died who were asleep until then receive with the living "immortality"!

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> Don't let this throw you my friend; Paul is clear sometimes (<u>II Peter 3</u>) on what he teaches about the law. (<u>Romans 2:12, 2:13, 2:23, 3:19-20, 3:31, 7:1, 7:7</u>, here's what the strength of the law means to Paul <u>7:9</u>, here's more <u>7:12, 7:22, 7:25, 8:3-4</u> ok that's enough of the many more I could show you of how Paul relates to the Law, and friend it's not as the deceived interpret Paul, and remember what Peter said or have you already forgotten? <u>II Peter 3:15-16</u>. The confusion is Paul was called as a preacher to the Gentiles but also to try and teach the Jews that the Sacrificial Law was done away with by Christs sacrifice nailed to the cross as it were, but because of the perversion of Gods forth commandment of HIs law and its rejection by the present churches following after the worship of the Beast of Revelations (Rev. 14:) the nominal churches teach that Gods law was altered by Jesus, and this is just one more lie the unlearned of scripture wrestle with and can be lost as a result when the truth is so clear what Paul and Jesus taught about the Law of God. (<u>Matthew 5:17-20</u>, <u>Deut. 7:9</u>) that's the same as saying forever, or until time ends with this worlds destruction and the new heavens and new earth created Jesus referenced in what we just read. The churches today have many, many false teachings (most we won't get to in this study) so many, it caused Jesus to predict this about the end of time; (<u>Matthew 24:3-4,11, 15</u>)

Not when we die, only those who have immortality can live in heaven, <u>that's the whole reason Jesus is</u> <u>coming back to get us</u> to take us there (where I go He said-<u>John 14:2-3</u>) to live forever and we can't do that till we have been changed from mortal to immortal, get it?

"That doesn't happen for any mortal until the second coming, when Jesus comes in the clouds and every eye shall see Him coming, and some are raised to eternal life and some sent to their grave to wait for the resurrection of the "second death" (Rev. 20:6,9,14-how clear) and these lost are sent to their end by the fires of hell yes, but to an everlasting sleep not to an everlasting burning in Hell forever and ever, "kept alive by immortality" by God none the less, just to suffer and yet not die? By the hands of a vengeful god head, that's not my God my savior who died that everyman and woman could live forever, but that's another story on the revere side of this book, The telling of another lie Satan is deceiving people with, and guess what? It comes from the same Dark Ages source (the Mother) and with the same consequences of "99% of Protestants buying in", because; their false shepherds have been deceived, teaching these deceptions, even though get this, they have read the same texts we have read at least once and if not why! Here's your clues; [and tune in for the back-up starting at the back of this booklet, unless you read it first, then you know the whole story from the Bible already;



## HELL AND THE DEAD<sup>4</sup>

Hell - is it really a present reality?

The answer is an emphatic NO!

That's the Bible speaking, and not all the so called men of the cloth who have given into one of the greatest deceptions in religion that has swept the whole of it.

Used to be, in the time of the Messiah, there were only two groups that were divided on the subject of people living forever via a resurrection, those were the Pharisees and the Sadducees (Mark 12:18) and Jesus dealt directly with each, and had a lot to say about heaven as well as Hell, based of course on the Old Testament scriptures, which were all that He had as religious back up then. (Think about it)

Later when the disciples finally wrote down their experiences with the Messiah, including Paul, they also addressed this subject, and then, after Jesus went back to heaven he sent John the visions of Revelation, and its there, in the messages sent to him from Christ, where we conclude the story of a place and time called "Hell".

Why do I say a time called Hell?

Well, I gave you the clues in the other side of this book, the punch line as it were, that tells us all about Hell and "when it will be" therefore it's a time called Hell not a place.

Now I know what's being taught about this subject out there, and I've read all the references to it in the scriptures both Old Testament (Jesus' religious guide of His own penning so to speak) and the New Testament which confirm and "are confirmed" by the Old Testament.

You see each testament depends on the other, and if you eliminate one you've more or less eliminated the understanding of the other, thus so has Satan influenced "his deceived" in doing so, but in the case of subjects like this on Hell, as we saw on the one about heaven, you got to refer to both to understand the Truth of the matter, and how those Truths influence our understanding of the Dead which is really our primary subject here.

Satan will keep anyone; preachers, PHD's, Masters of Divinity (who have seen the truth and rejected it at some point in their studies), including Professors (rightly named) and common people like you and me, keeping us from the truth "anyway he can", and the best way he [Satan] has found to be successful in

keeping us in the dark is for us to not know what God has taught in Scriptures "from creation to present", and that knowledge of, and from God, is only found in the "Bible and the Bible only", no other source can we "base Truth upon", certainly not any religion of the tens of 1000's Christian, Muslim, Jew sects just naming the three most influential as far as claiming the same God as their inheritance. (See <u>www.theuniversalreligion.com</u> for more details on what I mean by that, and for a study of "Gods Religion" not man's)

If we don't point back to the only trustable source for our proofs, including History of course "that we can establish naturally, then the result of what we learn or study, read or write, hear and believe as our faith will not be of God, but simply "the source we quote". Can't you see that? Let's go on...

Like I said; before I got carried away with important prerequisites, I have already given you the only two texts one needs to know of the Truth about Hell, so, let's look at them again and expound upon them using other scriptures to support <u>the only conclusions we can make</u> "if the Bible is consistently true and does not contradict itself" as some, even clergy, make false claims against it.

God is not the author of confusion "man is" end quote. Remember; "I would not have you ignorant" Paul said – look it up.

Ok, let's look at them again;

#### Malachi 4:3

# <sup>3</sup>And ye shall tread down the wicked; for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet in the day that I shall do this, saith the LORD of hosts.

Ok, there's the one about the wicked. Deceived of those who choose to be lost like Cain. Either this man [Malachi] was a false prophet "or" the Lord was speaking through him, which I'm convinced is the case if you read the whole of his book "in context" to the rest of the Bible.

Of course; if you do like some do, or actually about how all do, they just take someone else's word for what's true and what's not, and then you've got the born again preachers who may have come across this text and either dismissed it due to his upbringing or blatantly ignored it because of the implications of accepting it as Truth and losing his job or TV show, audience.

Then there's the PHD's, you know, the Doctors of Divinity and MD's who claim to be masters of the scriptures, who can talk you right out of believing even the simplest of statements, no matter how obvious they are like the one above, and they go to the Hebrew or the Greek and say that's really not what it's saying or it just wasn't translated properly, while the truth is; "it's not what their university teaches and contrary to the religion that owns it" so they hold to their error, and these errors have been taught so long as traditions that they have to accept it or get out of the religion all together. Research sometime what happened to some preachers who wanted to clean up their church of such Biblical errors and what happened to them you won't believe it, especially those protestors (Protestants) during the Dark Ages, Luther, Huss etc.. (Or go to "Watchman" at <u>www.mosescats.com</u>)

All and all when it comes down to choice; the Bible remains subjective only in that; because in the end, it's we who decide what to believe whether it's the preacher that has deceived or mesmerized us, or the Word of God plain and simple.

I say this text is obvious, and cannot be misconstrued in any fashion, for we know that everything of this earth is going to be burnt up in the end and a new heaven and a new heaven and earth (universe implied) re-created without sin, but if sin is still out there in the universe or down below the ashes, then it could rise again, and really friend; how would you enjoy paradise knowing that somewhere out there or down there is your loved one, who made a bad choice near the end of a good life, as they were known for their right doing, but that one decision to follow Satan and not God that they would not confess nor repent, that one unforgiven sin, and "like Cain" they walked away from Gods truth in their heart and mind, and while of course appearing to be a Godly person, never missing church, but they were lost for whatever reason, and only God knew it no one else, but when the resurrection took place they didn't come up at that last trump with the righteous dead to a new life (see other side of book for scriptural backup) and now, they are out there somewhere burning and burning, and burning forever and ever "and not dyeing"! How I ask you could anyone enjoy paradise knowing they are out there somewhere in the worst of agony known to man?

It's a foolish scenario at best, and will not be the case, for God is a merciful God and would not use the tactics of Satan through his man Hitler, who as we know burnt people up for what he thought was a righteous act, no my friend "God is not worse than Hitler in killing people alive", giving them immortality only to torture them forever and ever, at least they died under Hitler, but you're telling me that God is going to miraculously keep them alive forever just to burn them with intense fire "that never turns them to ashes as He has shown us though His prophet here will be the real case?"

No my friend, and the devil is not going to be in charge of Hell either for he gets the same treatment, the same merciful treatment of being burnt, yes, but not forever, for he too (Satan) will also be turned to ashes!

#### Ezekiel 28:18

# <sup>18</sup>Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries by the multitude of thine iniquities, by the iniquity of thy traffick; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and <u>I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth</u> in the sight of all them that behold thee.

If by Gods grace we are awakened in the first resurrection (John 5:29,) by the sound of the last trump and the voice of the archangel or caught up with them to paradise, and are alive at the end of that thousand years reign, to participate in the third coming, and witness the resurrection of the wicked dead at the end of that thousand years reign, then we will be the ones here mentioned who will watch the impossible act of bringing a spiritual being (Satan) to ashes "by a merciful God who won't even torture the man responsible for trillions upon trillions of people being lost and a whole world having to be destroyed because of him", NO! The Merciful loving God will end his (Satan's) life as the others for good! Out of His sight, as sin and death even Hell itself will be burn up to never be again.

#### Did you know that<sup>5</sup>?

Animate and inanimate (beings and things) connected to sin will be cast into that lake of fire for removal forever and ever (this is how that phrase fits by the way) all connected o sin will be taken away from not only our sight but Gods sight who sees all, to never "forever and ever" rise again in the whole of the universe, and it happens right here on this earth's surface!

Notice the clear text below, one that needs no separate translation or priest to explain them, for they stand clearly on their own. However I'm going to interline to make things clear, and you can read them or ignore them, but you will still get the same conclusions I've come to "by just thinking and putting it together with all of scripture "Old and New", and only then will we have some understanding of these and all things allowing us to see the truth of this matter, without prejudice or preconceived input from some false preacher or prophet, I hope;

#### Rev 20:

<sup>1</sup>And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand.
 <sup>2</sup>And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,
 <sup>3</sup>And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

(Now I ask you; "can one take a literal chain and bound a spiritual being with it?"

Of course not, so what we are talking about here is; "during the thousand years period when the earth will be rendered desolate by God, save for Satan and his angels who are 'bound' to it [the earth] thus the earth is like a bottomless pit which has no top bottom width or breast to its (his) boundaries, so too are they being bound not only to the space of the earth, Satan et al, it's as if they are bound with chains, but it's chains of circumstances. Because they will have no one to tempt or deceive as we read, for the righteous dead are in heaven and the wicked were destroyed by the brightness of Christ's coming, (<u>II Thessalonians 2:8</u>) and the mountains have fallen into the sea, and great earthquakes have destroyed the surface of the planet, (<u>II Peter3:12</u>) and it's laying void for Satan to ponder over what he has accomplished by his own doing which is nothing. Thus he and his angels will be sealed by God as it were till the thousand years have expired.

John now turns to see the righteous in heaven ;)

<sup>4</sup>And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, (Remember this?) or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

(They are in heaven while Satan's bound to this earth for that 1000 years.)

If you think he ought to burn forever and ever along with the wicked then let me introduce to you someone like you...Hitler...a good bed fellow for you for that was his philosophy, and of course yours too? But don't you dare pin that on the eternally merciful God of love, the One I suppose you are in disagreement with. Oh sure He will commit His strange act of eliminating evil once and for all, but even in that strange act he God will remain merciful, faithful.

#### <sup>5</sup>But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. <sup>6</sup>Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.

(The first resurrection was of the righteous as we proved in the heaven part of this book, but the wicked dead will not be raised until the thousand years were finished, and they will receive what? "A second death", so; where were they during the 1000 years? "Dead, asleep in their graves, waiting to be awakened, resurrected, doesn't this then tell us that they could not have been in purgatory or hell burning?

No more than the righteous dead were in heaven before the first resurrection!

It's not until the thousand years begin "at the first resurrection that the dead go to heaven", how else could one see this? It's not until the end of the thousand years that the wicked dead are resurrected, how else can one see this as well?

It all fits into one scenario one prophetic description as we are seeing; only those who pervert the truth, for their advantage of controlling people's minds and hearts, see it different than the Word of God tells it, and the rest are deceived by their traditions which they will hold to even when the truth, much less logic, <u>stares them in the face</u>!)

<sup>7</sup>And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, <sup>8</sup>And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog, and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea. <sup>9</sup>And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God <u>out of heaven, and devoured them</u>.

(Here it is! When Hell is first initiated, and it only lasts until it's done its job of eliminating everything that surrounded sin including the deceived, deceivers and the father of sin root and brach)

<sup>10</sup>And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

(Remember the ashes part we read, thus how this phrase "forever and forever is used then; meaning until its ending or the fire has done its work of devouring it all "till nothings left but ashes, and for how long will that destruction of sin last? "Forever and forever never to be again, brought to ashes which have no life in them both Animate and inanimate destroyed root and branch forever! (Malachi 4:1)

(John now sees the earth and heaven gone, and judgment pronounced, and as a result of the decision of the courts of heaven all those who names were found in either the book of life or loss, the pronouncement is made and the "finality of sin is determined and the judgment carried out" and notice particularly what happens to "HELL" itself ;)

<sup>11</sup>And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

<sup>12</sup>And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. <sup>13</sup>And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.
<sup>14</sup>And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.
<sup>15</sup>And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

#### CONCLUSION

I think it's clear about where, when and what Hell is, but it's not clear where we are going to reside; either in eternity alive as righteous beings (by the grace of God and not of ourselves who were once like Cain but no more) or as the ashes under their feet?

It all depends on our knowledge "of Gods knowledge" my friend, and whether we are going to be deceived away from Gods clear and uncomplicated Truths, by falling for the deceivers, the false prophets and the miracles that will accompany their false religions in the end (our time now), orchestrated by none other than Satan who wants us to be destroyed with him, and we just read all will be burned up to ashes?

Will we bow to Satan's religion, or worship Gods religion that was first established in Creation; "Worship Him by His creation of even a separate day made especially for worship, then He numbered it and set it in His week<sup>6</sup> "at the conclusion of His Creation", given <u>so that we would</u> <u>always with every consecutive week from thence, so that on His day we will always look back</u> <u>and remember "our creator and re-creator</u>".
